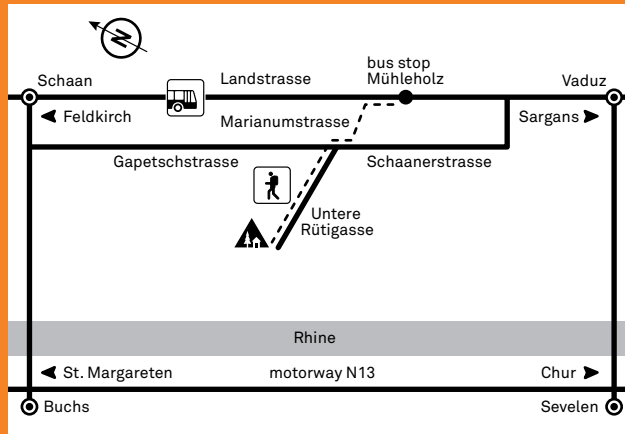




One of the smallest countries in Europe. The compact Principality of Liechtenstein, nestling in the mountains between Switzerland and Austria, extends from the Rhine Valley up to an altitude of more than 2,500 metres. Just eleven villages and 35,000 inhabitants go to make up this little country and yet it offers its guests a diversity that leaves nothing to be desired. Cultural tourists will find a host of top-class attractions ranging from the renowned art museum to the popular festival summer, while adventurous travellers will delight in the princely infrastructure while hiking, cycling and inline skating.

The capital of this small country is Vaduz. It is the government seat of the Prince, who resides in his medieval ancestral castle overlooking Vaduz. Conspicuous from far afield, majestic and unapproachable, the castle exerts a magical attraction. The royal residence is also a symbol of the country – after all, how many castles are home to a real prince?

How to get there Take the train to Sargans, Buchs or Feldkirch. Change to the postbus. Get off at the “Mühleholz” stop from where it is a five-minute walk to the youth hostel.
